As you constituent and a resident of [city, state], I am writing to encourage you to maintain support for proven global health investments that have saved millions of lives around the world and that protect the safety, security, and prosperity of Americans.

As Congress considers funding for Fiscal Year 2027, I ask that you request funding in the National Security, State Department, and Related Programs Appropriations bill for three vital public-private partnerships that return billions to the U.S. through investments in medical manufacturing, commodities, services, and technology: **Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance (Gavi); the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis, and Malaria (the Global Fund); and the President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR).**

- Since 2000, **Gavi has averted more than 20 million deaths and vaccinated 1.2 billion children.** Gavi spends more in the U.S. than the U.S. spends on Gavi, making it a smart American investment. It has a proven record of building self-reliance, with 19 of Gavi's original recipient nations now fully funding their own programs.
- Since 2002, the **Global Fund has saved 70 million lives.** In 15 years, the Global Fund has returned more than \$3.5 billion to U.S. companies through the purchase of medical commodities, technology, and services.
- Since 2003, **PEPFAR has saved 26 million lives and enabled more than 7 million babies to be born HIV-free.** In 2024, PEPFAR ensured more than 20 million people were on lifesaving HIV prevention and treatment drugs and more than 6 million orphans received critical care.

I urge you to continue U.S. investment in these successful programs, and to push the administration to spend existing funds in line with the law. Thank you for your consideration, and I look forward to hearing back from you.
